Louise Chesley began her gymnastics career at Delbrook High School (North Vancouver) in 1958. She would go on to become BC Champion, an Olympian (Rome, 1960), and a silver medalist at the 1962 Pan American Games in Texas. She founded the Flicka Gymnastics Club in North Vancouver. After graduating from UBC in 1965 as Valedictorian, Louise became the PE Department Head at Aldergrove Community Secondary School – a position she maintained until her retirement in 1999.

In the early years, after running a recreational gymnastics and trampoline club, Louise's athletes began to compete and achieved regional, Western Canadian and National results. When Charlie Nash restored BC High School competitions in 1981, Louise again took up the challenge. Annually, she organized the Langley District, Upper Fraser Valley, and on occasion, the Fraser Valley competitions. Each year, the girls and boys Aldergrove teams qualified for the BC Finals and proved to be strong contenders, winning many awards.

Louise was also a long standing member of the BCSSGA Board of Directors as well as on the Fraser Valley Executive. She was acknowledged as one of the first recipients of the BC Sports "Lifetime Achievement Sports Award." However, the achievement that she most cherished was the naming of the Aldergrove School Gymnastics Gym in her honor, where a plaque is there today that recognizes her 33 years of dedication to her athletes. There is also a \$900 scholarship in her name that continues to be awarded to a student recognizing their community or school sports involvement.

Apart from all the awards and accolades, Louise's philosophy never wavered. Winning was good but personal achievement of the athletes was paramount. She never turned away an enthusiast, no matter how challenged, and she always encouraged each individual to be the best they could be – athletically, academically, and more importantly, in the pursuit of a positive lifestyle that many had never before envisioned. Because of her legacy, Aldergrove gymnasts have become better people and a tribute to her complete coaching/mentoring system. They will remember her and she will be missed. This bursary in her name is a

memorial to the epitome of gymnastics excellence. To all destined to emulate Louise Chesley's example: "Follow your dreams".

The BCSSGA is proud to provide two \$250 bursaries to deserving student-athletes in grade 12.

# Women's Artistic Gymnastics (WAG) Events

<u>Vault</u>: The vault should have both height and distance, as well as good form from the springboard through to the landing. Competitors vault twice and the best score is counted.

<u>Uneven Bars</u>: The routine should be continuous, with movements flowing one into another. Swinging movements, in sequence, take the gymnast under and over the bars in both directions. Positions of support, standing or sitting should be momentary.

<u>Balance Beam</u>: The 16 ft long, 4" wide balance beam requires great concentration and discipline from the athlete. The composition of the routine should include combinations of turns, jumps, steps and leaps, tumbling, and dance.

<u>Floor Exercise</u>: Dance and tumbling ability, combined with the creativity and personality of the athlete, all performed to music, make floor one of the most popular of the gymnastics events.

## Men's Artistic Gymnastics (MAG) Events

<u>Floor Exercise</u>: The floor exercise includes a variety of tumbling, turns, acrobatics, balances, and momentary pauses. Sequences should be original and reveal the strength, agility, control and personality of the athlete, all with correct form and execution. Unlike the women, the men's floor exercise is not performed to music.

<u>Pommel Horse:</u> Swings, scissors, circles, and flairs, both forward and backward compose a routine on the pommel horse.

<u>Still Rings</u>: A routine on the rings will vary between strength elements, hold parts, and swinging movements, all without swinging the rings.


<u>Vault</u>: The men's vault is judged on form, execution, height, distance, and control, all based on the difficulty of the vault performed.

<u>Parallel Bars</u>: The routine consists of swinging, flight and strength elements. Form and execution must be maintained throughout while displaying strength and control.

<u>Horizontal</u> (<u>High</u>) <u>Bar</u>: Swings, circles, "in bar" elements, and release moves. As in every event, control of form and execution are a must.


